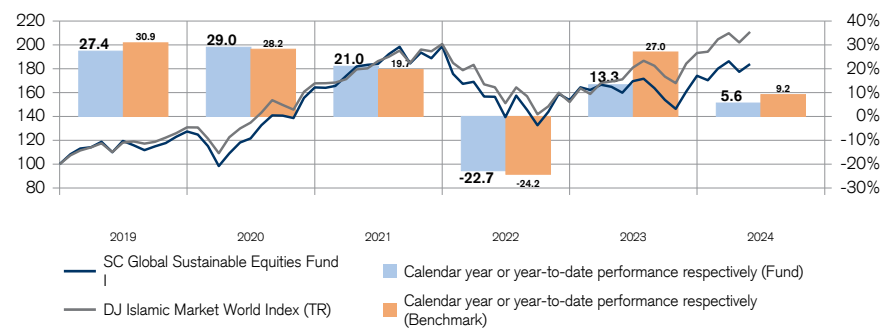

Net Performance in USD (rebased to 100) and yearly performance ¹⁾



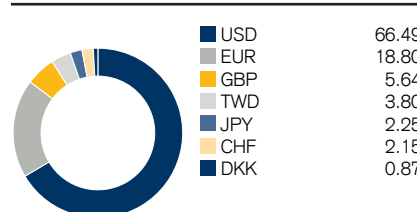

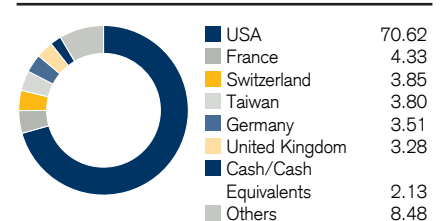

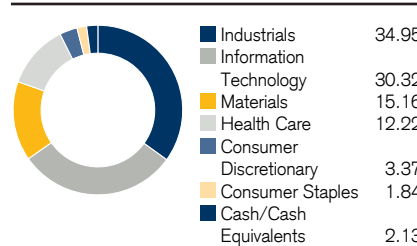
